
Response to deficiency letter dated April 10, 1996

This is a letter in response to your deficiency letter and request for information dated April 10, 1996. We will restrond to each of the issues and quastion individually.

1. I am enclosing for you the section from the current UL 544 Standards Manual on Leakage Current for Medical And Dental Boursment from



"decompression of the intervertebral discs and facet joints, that is unloading, due to distraction and positioning."

3. As stated in our previous letter the reference to "maintenance therapy" has been deleted.

4. The statements regarding 'diffusion gradients and healing process' was used for discussion purposes and will not appear in our labeling or promotional material.



- 5. The term "unique" has been discontinued in our labeling and promotional material.
- 6. The reference to "almost all patients" and "most people" will be deleted from our labeling and promotional material.
- 7. The reference "about 10 to 15 sessions are usually recommended as a course of therapy" will be deleted from our labeling and promotional material. References to "an average" number of sessions has been deleted. The promotional material will use the language "A Vax-D clinic practitioner will determine your course of therapy and whether or not you are a candidate for VAX-D Therapy".
- 8. The term "significant (ly)" will be deleted from our labeling and promotional material.
